“Learn Arabic Morphology”

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The Derived Nouns

The Active Participle

اسمُ الفاعِلِ

Let's Start

1- The Active Participle اسمُ الفاعِلِ indicates the person or being from whom the action emanates, e.g. from the verb لَعِبَ it becomes

لَاعِبٌ which means a person who plays. i.e.

player.

2- In 3 Root letter verbs الفعلُ الثلاثي, Active

Participle اسمُ الفاعلِ is formed by adding the letter “Alef” after the first letter, rendering a “Kassrah” to the second letter and “Tanween” - or the proper vowel according to the sentence - to the final letter. Thus, the general form فَعَلَ becomes فَاعِلٌ.

3- In The Dual Form – المثنى – in the Nominative

Case حالة الرفع - we add “Alef” and “Noon” to the end, thus the general form فَاعِلٌ becomes فَاعِلَانِ.

4- In The Dual Form – المثنى – in the Accusative case حالة النصب - we add “Yaaâ” and “Noon” to the end, thus the general form فاعل becomes فاعليه .

5- In The Dual Form – المثنى – in the Genitive case حالة الجر - we add “Yaaâ” and “Noon” to the end, thus the general form فاعل becomes فاعليه .

6- For the Singular Feminine Form, we add a round Taaâ ة inserted at the end of the Active Participle, thus فاعل becomes فاعلة .

7- For the Sound Masculine Plural جمّة المذكر السالم, in the Nominative Case حالة الرفع - we add “Waaw and Noon” وون to the end, thus the

general form **فَاعِلٌ** becomes **فَاعِلُونَ** .

8- For the Sound Masculine Plural **جَمْعُ الْمَذَكَّرِ السَّالِمِ**,
in the Accusative Case **حَالَةَ النَّصْبِ** - we add “Yaaâ
and Noon” **يَنَّ** to the end, thus the general
form **فَاعِلٌ** becomes **فَاعِلِيهِ**.

9- For the Sound Masculine Plural **جَمْعُ الْمَذَكَّرِ السَّالِمِ**,
in the Genitive Case **حَالَةَ الْجَرِّ** - we add “Yaaâ
and Noon” **يَنَّ** to the end, thus the general
form **فَاعِلٌ** becomes **فَاعِلِيهِ** .

10- For the Sound Feminine Plural **جَمْعُ الْمُؤَنَّثِ**
السَّالِمِ, in the Nominative Case **حَالَةَ الرَّفْعِ** - we add
“Alef and Taaâ” **آتْ** to the end, thus the
general form **فَاعِلٌ** becomes **فَاعِلَاتٌ** .

11- For the Sound Feminine Plural جَمْعُ الْمُؤَنَّثِ

السَّالِمِ, in the Accusative Case حالة النصب - we add
“Alef and Taaâ” اَتِ to the end, thus the
general form فَاعِلَاتٍ becomes فَاعِلَاتُ .

12- For the Sound Feminine Plural جَمْعُ الْمُؤَنَّثِ

السَّالِمِ, in the Genitive Case حالة الجرّ - - we add
“Alef and Taaâ” اَتِ to the end, thus the
general form فَاعِلَاتٍ becomes فَاعِلَاتُ .

**13- There are 3 scales for the Masculine form
and 3 for the Feminine form of the word as in
the following table:**

Genitive Case	Accusative case	Nominative Case	Gender

The Present Tense

- » To wash
- » To rinse
- » To clean
- » To flush
- » To lave

يَغْسِلُ

The Active Participle

- » Washer
- » Washer man
- » Laundry man
